

# 2022–2023 STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION

#### **Greetings Students,**

This is an info package and application form that could help you out with the cost of your NBC tuition this fall. You have the opportunity to apply for bursaries and other financial aid thanks to generous donors who value the training you will be receiving. You are eligible even if you are applying for a student loan.

#### **Steps**

- 1. Read the policies included in this package. Be sure to read all criteria carefully.
- 2. Choose the bursaries for which you wish to apply and check them off on the back of the application form.
- 3. Complete the forms thoroughly. You could be disqualified if you don't provide enough information.
- 4. Return applications to NBC, which must be postmarked by August 1. Recipients will be chosen first semester and the funds will be applied to second semester.
- 5. Feel free to contact me if you have any questions.

# NBC STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICY



#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### 1. Definition:

Student Financial Assistance (SFA) includes the NBC Student Aid Fund, annual bursaries and other financial awards not included in the Freshman Entrance Scholarships or in the awards presented during the Annual Awards Chapel.

These bursaries and Student Aid Fund are made available to students by application before the school year. The presentations are designated by recommendation from the Mission Leadership Team (Student Aid) & Academic Dean (Bursaries) according to the guidelines given below.

#### 2. Purpose:

The SFA program is intended to:

- give financial assistance to needy students
- · create and develop student character
- · promote conscientious academic effort

Therefore, both academic and non-academic factors are considered in the awarding of bursary monies.

- Application for the Student Aid Fund and the annual bursaries are opened at the beginning of each July. Presentation of the funds is made in September at the beginning of the semester.
- 4. All funds awarded by application are to be used for the student's second semester account, unless otherwise specified.
- 5. A student failing to complete the semester, for which funds have been awarded, must repay the total amount of the award by the end of that school term.
- In awarding bursary monies, preference will be given to applicants who are full-time students.
- 7. All applications will be processed by the Academic Dean and MLT. The Academic Dean shall oversee the Bursary program, while MLT shall oversee the Student Aid Fund and together will administer:
  - · the evaluation of applications
  - · the interviewing of applicants, as necessary
  - the presentation of the funds
  - · the establishment and processing of new bursaries or awards
- 8. Information regarding the SFA program shall be presented on the college website.

# STUDENT AID FUND



#### a. Aim:

Occasionally friends or constituents of the school donate designated funds for the purpose of helping out needy students. These donations are placed into this Fund, from which needy students may apply to receive financial help.

#### b. Recipients:

Each accepted NBC student is considered for the Student Aid Fund. However, the ones granted the aid must meet the following criteria:

- good Christian character
- positive Christian testimony
- positive contributions to school life
- absolute financial need
- approved stewardship of time and money

#### c. Purposes:

- to help students meet their educational expenses
- to assist students for essential school expenses such as tuition, room and board, and textbooks
- to discourage and prevent student drop-out due to finances

#### d. Policies:

- all possible aids are processed through the administration of MLT
- application forms are available from the college website

#### e. Administration:

Students who have financial need will be considered (and possibly be interviewed) by MLT, before any funds are distributed. Applications will be considered at the end of each August, provided that the Fund has money at that time.

# **DESCRIPTION OF BURSARIES**



#### 1. Ed & Mary Vellacott Memorial Bursary

Nipawin Bible College has been a big part of Ed & Mary Vellacott's life. Five of their children and three of their daughter-in-laws attended NBC in the 70s and 80s. Sons - Maurice (Mary Guenter), Tim (Diane Schierling), Randy (Joyce Rempel), Clint Daughter - Joy

Over the years, Ed & Mary also attended a number of NBC graduations, anniversary celebrations and senior retreats. Therefore, this annual bursary is given in their memory, and honors their dedication to biblical training.

Amount: \$1,500.00 (2 @ \$750.00)

Criteria: To be awarded to a student who:

- 1. Has a genuine financial need
- 2. Serves the Lord enthusiastically
- 3. Is devoted to sharing their faith

# 2. Dan and Dwight Koop Bursary

The Dan Koop family, in appreciation of NBC, have established an annual bursary of \$100. Mr. Koop took grades 5-10 at TRBI, and then graduated from NBI in 1963. He served on faculty and as Director of Missions from 1981–1992.

Amount: \$100.00

Criteria: To be awarded to a freshman student who:

- 1. Has financial need
- 2. Has intentions of completing his/her program at NBC
- 3. Has positive recommendation by the Academic Dean, the Dean of Students and the Business Manager.

# 3. NBC Alumni Bursary

The Alumni Association partnered with NBC gives this bursary to encourage alumni to promote NBC to their children.

Amount: \$500.00

Criteria: To be awarded to freshmen students whose:

1. Parent(s) are alumni of NBI or NBC

#### 4. NBC Junior Bursary

Because of its interest in the completion of studies for individual students at NBC, the school annually makes funds available for this bursary.

Amount: \$500.00 (2 [1 male, 1 female] \$250.00 each)

Criteria: Awarded to a junior student who:

- 1. Has demonstrated leadership abilities and works well with people
- 2. Is a good student of the Word and has potential teaching capability
- 3. Has evidenced satisfactory academic performance
- 4. Has evidenced a wholesome Christian testimony at NBC as well as at home
- 5. Has financial need

#### 5. Helen Snider Memorial Bursary

Helen Snider, a graduate of the Two Rivers Bible Institute, went home to her Maker in October, 1983. In memory of her life, an annual bursary has been established by her three sisters: Ethel Baxter, Blanche Hitchcock, and Neoma Snider, also alumni of NBC (TRBI).

Amount: \$100.00

Criteria: To be awarded to a returning student who:

- 1. Has a financial need
- 2. Displays evidence of maturing Christian character

# 6. Returning Student Bursary

Awarded to encourage those persevering through multiple years of training at NBC

Amount: \$800.00 (2 [1male & 1female] @ \$400.00 each)

Criteria: to be awarded to a returning student who:

- 1. Exemplifies servant leadership
- 2. Is returning for their second, third, or fourth year at NBC

#### 7. NBC Board of Directors Bursary

As an expression of their interest in the training of students at NBC, the members of the Board of Directors have established this annual bursary.

Amount: \$1,000.00 (2 @ \$500.00)

Criteria: Awarded to a returning student(s) who:

- 1. Demonstrates a genuine appreciation to the Nipawin Bible College and displays a spirit of NBC loyalty
- 2. Has financial need

#### 8. Mr. and Mrs. R.W. Snider Memorial Bursary

Mr. Snider (1979) and Mrs. Snider (1983) were one of the couples used of God in the founding of the Two Rivers Bible Institute. This annual bursary in honour of their dedication and service, has been established by their four daughters: Blanche Hitchcock, Neoma Snider, Cora Snider, and Ethel Baxter.

Amount: \$100.00

Criteria: To be awarded to a returning student who:

1. Is anticipating a missionary career

- 2. Shows excellence in their studies
- 3. Has a financial need
- 4. Has a consistent Christian character

# 9. <u>Dwayne Salmond Memorial Bursary</u>

In memory of their son Dwayne, Rod & Diane Salmond of Salmond Trucking Ltd. (Hudson Bay, SK) have made an annual bursary of \$500.00 to help a student with a significant financial need. Their desire is to help students who are planning on ministry or missions service, but are in jeopardy of not completing their program due to financial needs.

Amount: \$500.00

Criteria: To be awarded to a returning student who:

- 1. Is anticipating service in ministry or missions
- 2. Has a genuine and significant financial need

# 10. InterAct Ministries North Pacific Crescent Bursary

In an effort to encourage students tracking towards missions involvement, InterAct Ministries has established an annual bursary.

Amount: \$250.00

Criteria: to be awarded to a returning student, who best fulfils the following:

- 1. Pursuing a missions goal focused on Western Canada ministering among Aboriginal or East Indian Sikh or Muslim people groups
- 2. Similarly pursuing missions in Siberia or Alaska
- 3. An evidenced missions goal
- 4. Comes from a home where parents are involved in missions
- Has financial need

NOTE: Applicants need to clearly identify how they meet the criteria

# 11. Pastor & Missionary Bursary

Each year a bursary of \$1,000 is available for a student who is in the third or fourth year at NBC.

Amount: \$1,000.00

Criteria: To be awarded to a third- or fourth-year student who:

- 1. Is pursuing service in pastoral ministry or missions
- 2. Has a genuine financial need
- 3. Has maintained a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75
